Matthew 10:1 And when he had called unto [him] his twelve disciples, he gave them power [against] **unclean spirits**, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

Matthew 12:43 When the **unclean spirit** is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none.

To be under the power of a demon. In the New Testament, these are persons, afflicted with especially severe diseases, either bodily or mentally, (such as paralysis, blindness, deafness, loss of speech, epilepsy, melancholy, insanity, etc.) whose bodies in the opinion of the Jews demons had entered, and so held possession of them as not only to afflict them with ills, but also to dethrone the reason and take its place themselves; accordingly the possessed were wont to express the mind and consciousness of the demons dwelling in them; and their cure was thought to require the expulsion of the demon.

Matthew 4:24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were **possessed with devils**, and those which were lunatic, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them.

Matthew 8:16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were **possessed with devils**: and he cast out the spirits with [his] word, and healed all that were sick:

Matthew 8:28 And when he was come to the other side into the country of the Gergesenes, there met him two **possessed with devils**, coming out of the tombs, exceeding fierce, so that no man might pass by that way.

Matthew 8:33 And they that kept them fled, and went their ways into the city, and told every thing, and what was befallen to the **possessed of the devils**.
