SECTION FIVE -- PASSAGE ANALYSIS

1. POWER ENCOUNTERS IN MATTHEW

Matthew 4:23-25

Matt. 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing {2323} all manner of sickness {3554} and all manner of disease {3119} among the people. 24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick {2560} people that were taken with divers diseases {3554} and torments {931}, and those which were possessed with devils {1139}, and those which were lunatic {4583}, and those that had the palsy {3885}; and he healed {2323} them. 25 And there followed him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and [from] Decapolis, and [from] Jerusalem, and [from] Judaea, and [from] beyond Jordan.

Matthew 6:13

Matthew 6:13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For your is the kingdom, and the power {1411}, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

Matthew 7:21-23

Matt. 7:21-23 Not every one that says unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that does the will of my Father which is in heaven. 22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in your name {3686}? and in your name {3686} have cast out {1544} devils {1140}? and in your name {3686} done many wonderful {1411} works? 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, you that work iniquity.

Matthew 8:1-4

Matthew 8:1-4 When he was come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed him. 2 And, behold, there came a leper {3015} and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if you wilt, you canst make me clean {2511}. 3 And Jesus put forth [his] hand, and touched {0680} him, saying, I will; be you clean {2511}. And immediately his leprosy {3014} was cleansed {2511}. 4 And Jesus said unto him, See you tell no man; but go your way, show thyself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.

Matthew 8:5-13

Matt. 8:5-13 And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him, 6 And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy {3885}, grievously tormented. 7 And Jesus said unto him, I will come and heal {2323} him. 8 The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that you shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed {2390}. 9 For I am a man under

authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this [man], Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth [it]. 10 When Jesus heard [it], he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. 11 And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven. 12 But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. 13 And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go your way; and as you have believed, [so] be it done unto you. And his servant was healed {2390} in the selfsame hour.

Matthew 8:14-15

Matt. 8:14-15 And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever. 15 And he touched {0680} her hand, and the fever {4446} left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them.

Matthew 8:16-17

Matt. 8:16-17 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils {1139}: and he cast out {1544} the spirits {4151} with [his] word, and healed {2323} all that were sick {2560}: 17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare [our] sicknesses {3554}.

Matthew 8:23-27

Matthew 8:23-27 And when he was entered into a ship, his disciples followed him. 24 And, behold, there arose a great tempest in the sea, insomuch that the ship was covered with the waves: but he was asleep. 25 And his disciples came to [him], and awoke him, saying, Lord, save {4982} us: we perish. 26 And he said unto them, Why are you fearful, O you of little faith? Then he arose, and rebuked {2008} the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm. 27 But the men marvelled, saying, What manner of man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey him!

Matthew 8:28-34

Matt. 8:28-34 And when he was come to the other side into the country of the Gergesenes, there met him two possessed with devils {1139}, coming out of the tombs, exceeding fierce, so that no man might pass by that way. 29 And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with you, Jesus, you Son of God? art you come hither to torment us before the time? 30 And there was a good way off from them an herd of many swine feeding. 31 So the devils {1142} besought him, saying, If you cast us out {1544}, suffer us to go away into the herd of swine. 32 And he said unto them, Go. And when they were come out {1831}, they went into the herd of swine: and, behold, the whole herd of swine ran violently down a steep place into the sea, and perished in the waters. 33 And they that kept them fled, and went their ways into the city, and told every thing, and what was befallen to the possessed of the devils {1139}. 34 And, behold, the whole city came out to meet Jesus: and when they saw him, they besought [him] that he would depart out of their coasts.

Matthew 9:2-8

Matthew 9:2-8 And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy {3885}, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy {3885}; Son, be of good cheer; your sins be forgiven you. 3 And, behold, certain of the scribes said within themselves, This [man] blasphemeth. 4 And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, Wherefore think you evil in your hearts? 5 For whether is easier, to say, [Your] sins be forgiven you; or to say, Arise, and walk? 6 But that you may know that the Son of man has power on earth to forgive sins, (then said he to the sick of the palsy {3885};) Arise, take up your bed, and go unto your house. 7 And he arose, and departed to his house. 8 But when the multitudes saw [it], they marvelled, and glorified God, which had given such power unto men.

Matthew 9:18

Matthew 9:18 While he spake these things unto them, behold, there came a certain ruler, and worshipped him, saying, My daughter is even now dead: but come and lay your hand upon {2007/5495} her, and she shall live.

Matthew 9:20-22

Matthew 9:20-22 And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood {0131} twelve years, came behind [him], and touched {0680} the hem of his garment: 21 For she said within herself, If I may but touch {0680} his garment, I shall be whole {4982}. 22 But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; your faith has made you whole {4982}. And the woman was made whole {4982} from that hour.

Matthew 9:27-31

Matthew 9:27-31 And when Jesus departed thence, two blind {5185} men followed him, crying, and saying, [Thou] Son of David, have mercy on us. 28 And when he was come into the house, the blind {5185} men came to him: and Jesus said unto them, Believe you that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord. 29 Then touched {0680} he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. 30 And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, See [that] no man know [it]. 31 But they, when they were departed, spread abroad his fame in all that country.

Matthew 9:32-34

Matt. 9:32-34 As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb {2974} man possessed with a devil {1139}. 33 And when the devil {1140} was cast out {1544}, the dumb {2974} spoke: and the multitudes marveled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel. 34 But the Pharisees said, He casts out {1544} devils {1140} through the prince of the devils {1140}.

Matthew 9:35-38

Matt. 9:35-38 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing {2323} every sickness {3554} and every disease {3119} among the people. 36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. 37 Then said he unto his disciples, The harvest truly [is] plenteous, but the labourers [are] few; 38 Pray you therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

Matthew 10:1

Matt. 10:1 And when he had called unto [him] his twelve disciples, he gave them power {1849} [against] unclean spirits {169/4151}, to cast them out {1544}, and to heal {2323} all manner of sickness {3554} and all manner of disease {3119}.

Matthew 10:5-8

Matt. 10:5-8 These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into [any] city of the Samaritans enter you not: 6 But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. 7 And as you go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. 8 Heal {2323} the sick {770}, cleanse {2511} the lepers {3015}, raise the dead, cast out {1544} devils {1140}: freely you have received, freely give.

Matthew 11:2-5

Matthew 11:2-5 Now when John had heard in the prison the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples, 3 And said unto him, Art you he that should come, or do we look for another? 4 Jesus answered and said unto them, Go and show John again those things which you do hear and see: 5 The blind {5185} receive their sight, and the lame {5560} walk, the lepers {3015} are cleansed {2511}, and the deaf {2974} hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them.

Matthew 11:18

Matt. 11:18 For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, He has a devil {1140}.

Matthew 11:20-23

Matthew 11:20-23 Then began he to upbraid the cities wherein most of his mighty {1411} works were done, because they repented not: 21 Woe unto you, Chorazin! woe unto you, Bethsaida! for if the mighty {1411} works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. 22 But I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the day of judgment, than for you. 23 And you, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell: for if the mighty {1411} works, which have been done in you, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.

Matthew 12:9-13

And when he was departed thence, he went into their synagogue: 10 And, behold, there was a man which had [his] hand withered {3584}. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal {2323} on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him. 11 And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift [it] out? 12 How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days. 13 Then said he to the man, Stretch forth your hand. And he stretched [it] forth; and it was restored whole {5199}, like as the other.

Matthew 12:14-21

Matt. 12:14-21 Then the Pharisees went out, and held a council against him, how they might destroy him. 15 But when Jesus knew [it], he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed {2323} them all; 16 And charged them that they should not make him known: 17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, 18 Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall show judgment to the Gentiles. 19 He shall not strive, nor cry; neither shall any man hear his voice in the streets. 20 A bruised reed shall he not break, and smoking flax shall he not quench, till he send forth judgment unto victory. 21 And in his name shall the Gentiles trust.

Matthew 12:22-23

Matt. 12:22-23 Then was brought unto him one possessed with a devil {1139}, blind {5185}, and dumb {2974}: and he healed {2323} him, insomuch that the blind {5185} and dumb {2974} both spoke and saw. 23 And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David?

Matthew 12:24-28

Matt. 12:24-28 But when the Pharisees heard [it], they said, This [fellow] does not cast out {1544} devils {1140}, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils {1140}. 25 And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand: 26 And if Satan cast out {1544} Satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand? 27 And if I by Beelzebub cast out {1544} devils {1140}, by whom do your children cast [them] out {1544}? therefore they shall be your judges. 28 But if I cast out {1544} devils {1140} by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Matthew 12:43-45

Matt. 12:43-45 When the unclean spirit {169/4151} is gone out of {1831} a man, he walks through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none. 44 Then he says, I will return into my house from whence I came out {1831}; and when he is come, he finds [it] empty, swept, and garnished. 45 Then goes he, and takes with himself seven other spirits more wicked than

himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last [state] of that man is worse than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.

Matthew 13:54

Matthew 13:54 And when he was come into his own country, he taught them in their synagogue, insomuch that they were astonished, and said, Whence has this [man] this wisdom, and [these] mighty works?

Matthew 13:58

Matthew 13:58 And he did not many mighty {1411} works there because of their unbelief.

Matthew 14:2 And said unto his servants, This is John the Baptist; he is risen from the dead; and therefore mighty {1411} works do show forth themselves in him.

Matthew 14:14

Matt. 14:14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed {2323} their sick.

Matthew 14:28-31

Matthew 14:28-31 And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be you, bid me come unto you on the water. 29 And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. 30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save {4982} me. 31 And immediately Jesus stretched forth [his] hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O you of little faith, wherefore didst you doubt?

Matthew 14:34-36

Matthew 14:34-36 And when they were gone over, they came into the land of Gennesaret. 35 And when the men of that place had knowledge of him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought unto him all that were diseased {2560}; 36 And besought him that they might only touch {0680} the hem of his garment: and as many as touched {0680} were made perfectly whole {1295}.

Matthew 15:21-28

Then Jesus went thence, and departed into the coasts of Tyre and Sidon. 22 And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, [you] Son of David; my daughter is grievously {2560} vexed {1139} with a devil {1139}. 23 But he answered her not a word. And his disciples came and besought him, saying, Send her away; for she cries after us. 24 But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel. 25 Then came she and worshipped him, saying, Lord, help me. 26 But he answered and said, It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast [it] to

dogs. 27 And she said, Truth, Lord: yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table. 28 Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great [is] your faith: be it unto you even as you wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.

Matthew 15:30-31

Matt. 15:30-31 And great multitudes came unto him, having with them [those that were] lame {5560}, blind {5185}, dumb, {2974} maimed {2948}, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed {2323} them: 31 Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb {2974} to speak, the maimed {2948} to be whole {5199}, the lame {5560} to walk, and the blind {5185} to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.

Matthew 17:14-22

Matt. 17:14-22 And when they were come to the multitude, there came to him a [certain] man, kneeling down to him, and saying, 15 Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatic {4583}, and sore {2560} vexed: for oftentimes he falls into the fire, and oft into the water. 16 And I brought him to your disciples, and they could not cure {2323} him. 17 Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him hither to me. 18 And Jesus rebuked {2008} the devil {1140}; and he departed out {1831} of him: and the child was cured {2323} from that very hour. 19 Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him {1544} out? 20 And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If you have faith as a grain of mustard seed, you shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. 21 Howbeit this kind goes not out but by prayer and fasting. 22 And while they abode in Galilee, Jesus said unto them, The Son of man shall be betrayed into the hands of men:

Matthew 19:2

Matt. 19:2 And great multitudes followed him; and he healed {2323} them there.

Matthew 19:13-15

Matthew 19:13-15 Then were there brought unto him little children, that he should put [his] hands on {2007/5495} them, and pray: and the disciples rebuked {2008} them. 14 But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven. 15 And he laid [his] hands on {2007/5495} them, and departed thence.

Matthew 20:30-34

Matthew 20:30-34 And, behold, two blind {5185} men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, [you] Son of David. 31 And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, [you] Son of David. 32 And Jesus stood still, and called them, and said, What will you that I shall do unto you? 33 They say unto him, Lord,

that our eyes may be opened. 34 So Jesus had compassion [on them], and touched {0680} their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed him.

Matthew 21:14-16

Matt. 21:14-16 And the blind {5185} and the lame {5560} came to him in the temple; and he healed {2323} them. 15 And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the Son of David; they were sore displeased, 16 And said unto him, Hearest you what these say? And Jesus said unto them, Yea; have you never read, Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings you have perfected praise?

Matthew 24:24

Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs {4592} and wonders {5059}; insomuch that, if [it were] possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

2. POWER ENCOUNTERS IN MARK

Mark 1:23-28

Mark 1:23-28 And there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit {169/4151}; and he cried out, 24 Saying, Let [us] alone; what have we to do with you, you Jesus of Nazareth? art you come to destroy us? I know you who you art, the Holy One of God. 25 And Jesus rebuked {2008} him, saying, Hold your peace, and come out {1831} of him. 26 And when the unclean spirit {169/4151} had torn him, and cried with a loud voice, he came out of him. 27 And they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new doctrine [is] this? for with authority {1849} commandeth {2004} he even the unclean spirits {169/4151}, and they do obey him. 28 And immediately his fame spread abroad throughout all the region round about Galilee.

Mark 1:30-31

Mark 1:30-31 But Simon's wife's mother lay sick of a fever, and anon they tell him of her. 31 And he came and took her by the hand, and lifted her up; and immediately the fever left her, and she ministered unto them.

Mark 1:32-34

Mark 1:32-34 And at even, when the sun did set, they brought unto him all that were diseased {2560}, and them that were possessed with devils {1139}. 33 And all the city was gathered together at the door. 34 And he healed {2323} many that were sick {2560} of divers diseases {3554}, and cast out {1544} many devils {1140}; and suffered not the devils {1140} to speak, because they knew him.

Mark 1:39

Mark 1:39 And he preached in their synagogues throughout all Galilee, and cast out {1544} devils {1140}.

Mark 1:40-44

Mark 1:40-44 And there came a leper {3015} to him, beseeching him, and kneeling down to him, and saying unto him, If you wilt, you canst make me clean {2511}. 41 And Jesus, moved with compassion, put forth [his] hand, and touched {0680} him, and said unto him, I will; be you clean {2511}. 42 And as soon as he had spoken, immediately the leprosy {3014} departed from him, and he was cleansed {2511}. 43 And he straitly charged him, and forthwith sent him away; 44 And said unto him, See you say nothing to any man: but go your way, show thyself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing those things which Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.

Mark 2:1-12

Mark 2:1-12 And again he entered into Capernaum after [some] days; and it was noised that he was in the house. 2 And straightway many were gathered together, insomuch that there was no room to receive [them], no, not so much as about the door: and he preached the word unto them. 3 And they come unto him, bringing one sick of the palsy {3885}, which was borne of four. 4 And when they could not come nigh unto him for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken [it] up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy {3885} lay. 5 When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy {3885}, Son, your sins be forgiven you. 6 But there were certain of the scribes sitting there, and reasoning in their hearts, 7 Why doth this [man] thus speak blasphemies? who can forgive sins but God only? 8 And immediately when Jesus perceived in his spirit that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, Why reason you these things in your hearts? 9 Whether is it easier to say to the sick of the palsy {3885}, [Your] sins be forgiven you; or to say, Arise, and take up your bed, and walk? 10 But that you may know that the Son of man has power on earth to forgive sins, (he said to the sick of the palsy {3885}.) 11 I say unto you, Arise, and take up your bed, and go your way into your house. 12 And immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went forth before them all; insomuch that they were all amazed, and glorified God, saying, We never saw it on this fashion.

Mark 3:1-5

Mark 3:1-5 And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand. 2 And they watched him, whether he would heal {2323} him on the sabbath day; that they might accuse him. 3 And he said unto the man which had the withered hand, Stand forth. 4 And he said unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace. 5 And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he said unto the man, Stretch forth your hand. And he stretched [it] out: and his hand was restored whole {5199} as the other.

Mark 3:10-12

Mark 3:10-12 For he had healed {2323} many; insomuch that they pressed upon him for to touch {0680} him, as many as had plagues {3148}. 11 And unclean spirits {169/4151}, when they saw him, fell down before him, and cried, saying, you art the Son of God. 12 And he straitly charged them that they should not make him known.

Mark 3:14-15

Mark 3:14-15 And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach, 15 And to have power {1849} to heal {2323} sicknesses {3554}, and to cast out {1544} devils {1140}:

Mark 3:22-23

Mark 3:22-23 And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He has {2192} Beelzebub, and by the prince of the devils {1140} casteth he out {1544} devils {1140}. 23 And

he called them [unto him], and said unto them in parables, How can Satan cast out {1544} Satan?

Mark 3:22-30

Mark 3:22-30 And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He has Beelzebub, and by the prince of the devils {1140} casteth he out {1544} devils {1140}. 23 And he called them [unto him], and said unto them in parables, How can Satan cast out {1544} Satan? 24 And if a kingdom be divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. 25 And if a house be divided against itself, that house cannot stand. 26 And if Satan rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but has an end. 27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house. 28 Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme: 29 But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost has never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation: 30 Because they said, He has {2192} an unclean spirit {169/4151}.

Mark 4:37-41

Mark 4:37-41 And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full. 38 And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest you not that we perish? 39 And he arose, and rebuked the wind {2008}, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. 40 And he said unto them, Why are you so fearful? how is it that you have no faith? 41 And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?

Mark 5:1-13

Mark 5:1-16 And they came over unto the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gadarenes. 2 And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit {169/4151}, 3 Who had [his] dwelling among the tombs; and no man could bind him, no, not with chains: 4 Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any [man] tame him. 5 And always, night and day, he was in the mountains, and in the tombs, crying, and cutting himself with stones. 6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him, 7 And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with you, Jesus, [you] Son of the most high God? I adjure you by God, that you torment me not. 8 For he said unto him, Come out {1831} of the man, [you] unclean spirit {169/4151}. 9 And he asked him, What [is] your name? And he answered, saying, My name [is] Legion: for we are many. 10 And he besought him much that he would not send them away out of the country. 11 Now there was there nigh unto the mountains a great herd of swine feeding. 12 And all the devils {1142} besought him, saying, Send us into the swine, that we may enter into {1525/1519} {1525/1519} them. 13 And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits {169/4151} went out {1831}, and entered into {1525/1519} the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, (they were about two thousand;) and were choked in

the sea. 14 And they that fed the swine fled, and told [it] in the city, and in the country. And they went out to see what it was that was done.

Mark 5:15-18

Mark 5:15-18 And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil {1139}, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid. 16 And they that saw [it] told them how it befell to him that was possessed with the devil {1139}, and [also] concerning the swine. 17 And they began to pray him to depart out of their coasts. 18 And when he was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the devil {1139} prayed him that he might be with him.

Mark 5:22-23; 35-43

Mark 5:22-23; 35-43 / 22 And, behold, there cometh one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name; and when he saw him, he fell at his feet, 23 And besought him greatly, saying, My little daughter lieth at the point of death: [I pray you], come and lay your hands on {2007/5495} her, that she may be healed {4982}; and she shall live.

While he yet spake, there came from the ruler of the synagogue's [house certain] which said, Your daughter is dead: why troublest you the Master any further? 36 As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he said unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only believe. 37 And he suffered no man to follow him, save Peter, and James, and John the brother of James. 38 And he cometh to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and seeth the tumult, and them that wept and wailed greatly. 39 And when he was come in, he said unto them, Why make you this ado, and weep? the damsel is not dead, but sleepeth. 40 And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying. 41 And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto you, arise. 42 And straightway the damsel arose, and walked; for she was [of the age] of twelve years. And they were astonished with a great astonishment. 43 And he charged them straitly that no man should know it; and commanded that something should be given her to eat.

Mark 5:25-34

Mark 5:25-34 And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years, 26 And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse, 27 When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched {0680} his garment. 28 For she said, If I may touch {0680} but his clothes, I shall be whole {4982}. 29 And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in [her] body that she was healed {2390} of that plague {3148}. 30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that virtue {1411} had gone out {1831} of him, turned him about in the press, and said, Who touched {0680} my clothes? 31 And his disciples said unto him, you seest the multitude thronging you, and sayest you, Who touched {0680} me? 32 And he looked round about to see her that had done this thing. 33 But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before him, and told him all the truth. 34

And he said unto her, Daughter, your faith has made you whole {4982}; go in peace, and be whole {5199} of your plague {3148}.

Mark 6:2

Mark 6:2 And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing [him] were astonished, saying, From whence has this [man] these things? and what wisdom [is] this which is given unto him, that even such mighty {1411} works are wrought by his hands?

Mark 6:4-6

Mark 6:4-6 But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house. 5 And he could there do no mighty work {1411}, save that he laid his hands upon {2007/5495} a few sick {732} folk, and healed {2323} [them]. 6 And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.

Mark 6:7-13

Mark 6:7-13 And he called [unto him] the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power {1849} over unclean spirits {169/4151}; 8 And commanded them that they should take nothing for [their] journey, save a staff only; no scrip, no bread, no money in [their] purse: 9 But [be] shod with sandals; and not put on two coats. 10 And he said unto them, In what place soever you enter into an house, there abide till you depart from that place. 11 And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when you depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city. 12 And they went out, and preached that men should repent. 13 And they cast out {1544} many devils {1140}, and anointed with oil many that were sick, and healed {2323} [them].

Mark 6:14

Mark 6:14 And king Herod heard [of him]; (for his name was spread abroad:) and he said, That John the Baptist was risen from the dead, and therefore mighty {1411} works do show forth themselves in him.

Mark 6:54-56

Mark 6:54-56 And when they were come out of the ship, straightway they knew him, 55 And ran through that whole region round about, and began to carry about in beds those that were sick {2560}, where they heard he was. 56 And whithersoever he entered, into villages, or cities, or country, they laid the sick {770} in the streets, and besought him that they might touch {0680} if it were but the border of his garment: and as many as touched {0680} him were made whole {4982}.

Mark 7:24-30

Mark 7:24-30 And from thence he arose, and went into the borders of Tyre and Sidon, and entered into an house, and would have no man know [it]: but he could not be hid. 25 For a [certain] woman, whose young daughter had {2192} an unclean spirit {169/4151}, heard of him, and came and fell at his feet: 26 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth {1544} the devil {1140} out of her daughter. 27 But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast [it] unto the dogs. 28 And she answered and said unto him, Yes, Lord: yet the dogs under the table eat of the children's crumbs. 29 And he said unto her, For this saying go your way; the devil {1140} is gone out {1831} of your daughter. 30 And when she was come to her house, she found the devil {1140} gone out {1831}, and her daughter laid upon the bed.

Mark 7:31-37

Mark 7:31-37 And again, departing from the coasts of Tyre and Sidon, he came unto the sea of Galilee, through the midst of the coasts of Decapolis. 32 And they bring unto him one that was deaf {2974}, and had an impediment in his speech; and they beseech him to put his hand upon {2007/5495} him. 33 And he took him aside from the multitude, and put his fingers into his ears, and he spit, and touched {0680} his tongue; 34 And looking up to heaven, he sighed, and said unto him, Ephphatha, that is, Be opened. 35 And straightway his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spake plain. 36 And he charged them that they should tell no man: but the more he charged them, so much the more a great deal they published [it]; 37 And were beyond measure astonished, saying, He has done all things well: he maketh both the deaf {2974} to hear, and the dumb {0216} to speak.

Mark 8:22-26

Mark 8:22-26 And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind {5185} man unto him, and besought him to touch {0680} him. 23 And he took the blind {5185} man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon {2007/5495} him, he asked him if he saw ought. 24 And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking. 25 After that he put [his] hands again upon {2007/5495} his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly. 26 And he sent him away to his house, saying, Neither go into the town, nor tell [it] to any in the town.

Mark 8:31-33

Mark 8:31-33 And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and [of] the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again. 32 And he spake that saying openly. And Peter took him, and began to rebuke {2008} him. 33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked {2008} Peter, saying, Get you behind me, Satan: for you savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.

Mark 9:17-29

Mark 9:17-29 And one of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto you my son, which has {2192} a dumb {0216} spirit {4151}; 18 And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and I spake to your disciples that they should cast him out {1544}; and they could not. 19 He answereth him, and said, O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him unto me. 20 And they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, straightway the spirit tare him; and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming. 21 And he asked his father, How long is it ago since this came unto him? And he said, Of a child. 22 And oftentimes it has cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if you canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us. 23 Jesus said unto him, If you canst believe, all things [are] possible to him that believeth. 24 And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help you mine unbelief. 25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked {2008} the foul spirit, saying unto him, [you] dumb {0216} and deaf {2974} spirit, I charge {2004} you, come out {1831} of him, and enter no more into {1525/1519} him. 26 And [the spirit] cried, and rent him sore, and came out {1831} of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead. 27 But Jesus took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose. 28 And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, Why could not we cast him out {1544}? 29 And he said unto them, This kind can come forth {1831} by nothing, but by prayer and fasting. (Mark 9)

Mark 9:38-39

Mark 9:38-39 And John answered him, saying, Master, we saw one casting out {1544} devils {1140} in your name {3686}, and he followeth not us: and we forbad him, because he followeth not us. 39 But Jesus said, Forbid him not: for there is no man which shall do a miracle {1411} in my name, that can lightly speak evil of me.

Mark 10:46-52

Mark 10:46-52 And they came to Jericho: and as he went out of Jericho with his disciples and a great number of people, blind {5185} Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side begging. 47 And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, [you] Son of David, have mercy on me. 48 And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, [you] Son of David, have mercy on me. 49 And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind {5185} man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; he calleth you. 50 And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus. 51 And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt you that I should do unto you? The blind {5185} man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight. 52 And Jesus said unto him, Go your way; your faith has made you whole {4982}. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.

Mark 13:22

Mark 13:22 For false Christs and false prophets shall rise, and shall show signs {4592} and wonders {5059}, to seduce, if [it were] possible, even the elect.

Mark 14:62

Mark 14:62 And Jesus said, I am: and you shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power {1411}, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

Mark 16:9

Mark 16:9 Now when [Jesus] was risen early the first [day] of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast {1544} seven devils {1140}.

Mark 16:15-18

Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go you into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs {4592} shall follow them that believe; In my name {3686} shall they cast out {1544} devils {1140}; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on {2007/5495} the sick, and they shall recover.

3. POWER ENCOUNTERS IN LUKE

Luke 1:35

Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon you, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow you: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of you shall be called the Son of God.

Luke 4:14

Luke 4:14 And Jesus returned in the power {1411} of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.

Luke 4:18

Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon me, because he has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he has sent me to heal <2390> the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind {5185}, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Luke 4:23-24

Luke 4:23-24 And he said unto them, You will surely say unto me this proverb, Physician, heal {2323} thyself: whatsoever we have heard done in Capernaum, do also here in your country. 24 And he said, Verily I say unto you, No prophet is accepted in his own country.

Luke 4:33-37

Luke 4:32-37 32 And they were astonished at his doctrine: for his word was with power. 33 And in the synagogue there was a man, which had {2192} a spirit {4151} of an unclean {169} devil {1140}, and cried out with a loud voice, 34 Saying, Let [us] alone; what have we to do with you, [you] Jesus of Nazareth? art you come to destroy us? I know you who you art; the Holy One of God. 35 And Jesus rebuked {2008} him, saying, Hold your peace, and come out {1831} of him. And when the devil {1140} had thrown him in the midst, he came out {1831} of him, and hurt him not. 36 And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word [is] this! for with authority {1849} and power {1411} he commandeth {2004} the unclean spirits {169/4151}, and they come out {1831}. 37 And the fame of him went out into every place of the country round about.

Luke 4:38-39

Luke 4:38-39 And he arose out of the synagogue, and entered into Simon's house. And Simon's wife's mother was taken with a great fever {4446}; and they besought him for her. 39 And he stood over her, and rebuked {2008} the fever {4446}; and it left her: and immediately she arose and ministered unto them.

Luke 4:40-41

Luke 4:40-41 Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick {770} with divers diseases {3554} brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on {2007/5495} every one of them, and healed {2323} them. 41 And devils {1140} also came out {1831} of many, crying out, and saying, you art Christ the Son of God. And he rebuking {2008} [them] suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ. (Luke 4)

Luke 5:12-15

Luke 5:12-15 And it came to pass, when he was in a certain city, behold a man full of leprosy {3014}: who seeing Jesus fell on [his] face, and besought him, saying, Lord, if you wilt, you canst make me clean {2511}. 13 And he put forth [his] hand, and touched {0680} him, saying, I will: be you clean {2511}. And immediately the leprosy {3014} departed from him. 14 And he charged him to tell no man: but go, and show thyself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing, according as Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them. 15 But so much the more went there a fame abroad of him: and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed {2323} by him of their infirmities.

Luke 5:17

Luke 5:17 And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power {1411} of the Lord was [present] to heal {2390} them.

Luke 6:6-11

Luke 6:6-11 And it came to pass also on another sabbath, that he entered into the synagogue and taught: and there was a man whose right hand was withered {3584}. 7 And the scribes and Pharisees watched him, whether he would heal {2323} on the sabbath day; that they might find an accusation against him. 8 But he knew their thoughts, and said to the man which had the withered {3584} hand, Rise up, and stand forth in the midst. And he arose and stood forth. 9 Then said Jesus unto them, I will ask you one thing; Is it lawful on the sabbath days to do good, or to do evil? to save life, or to destroy [it]? 10 And looking round about upon them all, he said unto the man, Stretch forth your hand. And he did so: and his hand was restored whole {5199} as the other. 11 And they were filled with madness; and communed one with another what they might do to Jesus.

Luke 6:17-19

Luke 6:17-19 And he came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of his disciples, and a great multitude of people out of all Judaea and Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear him, and to be healed {2390} of their diseases {3554}; 18 And they that were vexed {3791} with unclean spirits {169/4151}: and they were healed {2323}. 19 And the whole multitude sought to touch {0680} him: for there went {1831} virtue {1411} out of him, and healed {2390} [them] all.

Luke 7:2-10

Luke 7:2-10 And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear unto him, was sick {2560}, and ready to die. 3 And when he heard of Jesus, he sent unto him the elders of the Jews, beseeching him that he would come and heal {1295} his servant. 4 And when they came to Jesus, they besought him instantly, saying, That he was worthy for whom he should do this: 5 For he loveth our nation, and he has built us a synagogue. 6 Then Jesus went with them. And when he was now not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to him, saying unto him, Lord, trouble not thyself: for I am not worthy that you shouldest enter under my roof: 7 Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto you: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed. 8 For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth [it]. 9 When Jesus heard these things, he marvelled at him, and turned him about, and said unto the people that followed him, I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. 10 And they that were sent, returning to the house, found the servant whole that had been sick {770}.

Luke 7:12-16

Luke 7:12-16 Now when he came nigh to the gate of the city, behold, there was a dead man carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow: and much people of the city was with her. 13 And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not. 14 And he came and touched {0680} the bier: and they that bare [him] stood still. And he said, Young man, I say unto you, Arise. 15 And he that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And he delivered him to his mother. 16 And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God has visited his people.

Luke 7:20-23

Luke 7:20-23 When the men were come unto him, they said, John Baptist has sent us unto you, saying, Art you he that should come? or look we for another? 21 And in that same hour he cured {2323} many of [their] infirmities {3554} and plagues {3148}, and of evil spirits {4190/4151}; and unto many [that were] blind {5185} he gave sight. 22 Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things you have seen and heard; how that the blind {5185} see, the lame {5560} walk, the lepers {3015} are cleansed {2511}, the deaf {2974} hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached. 23 And blessed is [he], whosoever shall not be offended in me.

Luke 7:33

Luke 7:33 For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and you say, He has {2192} a devil {1140}.

Luke 8:1-2

Luke 8:1-2 And it came to pass afterward, that he went throughout every city and village, preaching and shewing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God: and the twelve [were] with him,

2 And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits {4190/4151} and infirmities {769}, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom {3739} went {1831} seven devils {1140}.

Luke 8:24-25

Luke 8:24-25 And they came to him, and awoke him, saying, Master, master, we perish. Then he arose, and rebuked {2008} the wind and the raging of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm. 25 And he said unto them, Where is your faith? And they being afraid wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this! for he commandeth {2004} even the winds and water, and they obey him.

Luke 8:26-40

Luke 8:26-40 And they arrived at the country of the Gadarenes, which is over against Galilee. 27 And when he went forth to land, there met him out of the city a certain man, which had {2192} devils {1140} long time, and ware no clothes, neither abode in [any] house, but in the tombs. 28 When he saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with you, Jesus, [you] Son of God most high? I beseech you, torment me not. 29 (For he had commanded the unclean spirit {169/4151} to come out {1831} of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil {1142} into the wilderness.) 30 And Jesus asked him, saying, What is your name? And he said, Legion: because many devils {1140} were entered into {1525/1519} him. 31 And they besought him that he would not command {2004} them to go out into the deep. 32 And there was there an herd of many swine feeding on the mountain: and they besought him that he would suffer them to enter into {1525/1519} them. And he suffered them. 33 Then went {1831} the devils {1140} out of the man, and entered into {1525/1519} the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were choked. 34 When they that fed [them] saw what was done, they fled, and went and told [it] in the city and in the country. 35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of {3739} whom the devils {1140} were departed {1831}, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid. 36 They also which saw [it] told them by what means he that was possessed of the devils {1139} was healed {4982}. 37 Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and he went up into the ship, and returned back again. 38 Now the man out of {3739} whom the devils {1140} were departed {1831} besought him that he might be with him: but Jesus sent him away, saying, 39 Return to your own house, and show how great things God has done unto you. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him. 40 And it came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people [gladly] received him: for they were all waiting for him.

Luke 8:41-42; 49-56

Luke 8:41-42; 49-56 And, behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: and he fell down at Jesus' feet, and besought him that he would come into his

house: 42 For he had one only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she lay a dying. But as he went the people thronged him.

While he yet spake, there cometh one from the ruler of the synagogue's [house], saying to him, Your daughter is dead; trouble not the Master. 50 But when Jesus heard [it], he answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole {4982}. 51 And when he came into the house, he suffered no man to go in, save Peter, and James, and John, and the father and the mother of the maiden. 52 And all wept, and bewailed her: but he said, Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth. 53 And they laughed him to scorn, knowing that she was dead. 54 And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise. 55 And her spirit came again, and she arose straightway: and he commanded to give her meat. 56 And her parents were astonished: but he charged them that they should tell no man what was done.

Luke 8:43-48

Luke 8:43-48 And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed {2323} of any, 44 Came behind [him], and touched {0680} the border of his garment: and immediately her issue of blood stanchd. 45 And Jesus said, Who touched {0680} me? When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said, Master, the multitude throng you and press [you], and sayest you, Who touched {0680} me? 46 And Jesus said, Somebody has touched {0680} me: for I perceive that virtue {1411} is gone out of me. 47 And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before him, she declared unto him before all the people for what cause she had touched {0680} him, and how she was healed immediately. 48 And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: your faith has made you whole {4982}; go in peace.

Luke 9:1-2

Luke 9:1-2 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power {1411} and authority {1849} over all devils {1140}, and to cure {2323} diseases {3554}. 2 And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal {2323} the sick {770}.

Luke 9:6

Luke 9:6 And they departed, and went through the towns, preaching the gospel, and healing {2323} every where.

Luke 9:37-42

Luke 9:37-42 And it came to pass, that on the next day, when they were come down from the hill, much people met him. 38 And, behold, a man of the company cried out, saying, Master, I beseech you, look upon my son: for he is mine only child. 39 And, lo, a spirit {4151} taketh {2192} him, and he suddenly crieth out; and it teareth him that he foameth again, and bruising him hardly departeth from him. 40 And I besought your disciples to cast him out; and they could not. 41 And Jesus answering said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you, and suffer you? Bring your son hither. 42 And as he was yet a coming, the devil

{1140} threw him down, and tare [him]. And Jesus rebuked {2008} the unclean spirit {169/4151}, and healed {2390} the child, and delivered him again to his father.

Luke 9:49-50

Luke 9:49-50 And John answered and said, Master, we saw one casting out {1544} devils {1140} in your name {3686}; and we forbad him, because he followeth not with us. 50 And Jesus said unto him, Forbid [him] not: for he that is not against us is for us.

Luke 9:51-56

Luke 9:51-56 And it came to pass, when the time was come that he should be received up, he stedfastly set his face to go to Jerusalem, 52 And sent messengers before his face: and they went, and entered into a village of the Samaritans, to make ready for him. 53 And they did not receive him, because his face was as though he would go to Jerusalem. 54 And when his disciples James and John saw [this], they said, Lord, wilt you that we command fire to come down from heaven, and consume them, even as Elias did? 55 But he turned, and rebuked {2008} them, and said, You know not what manner of spirit you are of. 56 For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save [them]. And they went to another village.

Luke 10:1-9

Luke 10:1-9 After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither he himself would come. 2 Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly [is] great, but the labourers [are] few: pray you therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest. 3 Go your ways: behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves. 4 Carry neither purse, nor scrip, nor shoes: and salute no man by the way. 5 And into whatsoever house you enter, first say, Peace [be] to this house. 6 And if the son of peace be there, your peace shall rest upon it: if not, it shall turn to you again. 7 And in the same house remain, eating and drinking such things as they give: for the labourer is worthy of his hire. Go not from house to house. 8 And into whatsoever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you: 9 And heal {2323} the sick {772} that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.

Luke 10:13

Luke 10:13 Woe unto you, Chorazin! woe unto you, Bethsaida! for if the mighty {1411} works had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have been done in you, they had a great while ago repented, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

Luke 10:17-20

Luke 10:17-20 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils {1140} are subject {5293} unto us through your name {3686}. 18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19 Behold, I give unto you power {1849} to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power {1411} of the enemy: and nothing shall by any

means hurt you. 20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

Luke 11:14

Luke 11:14 And he [Christ] was casting out a devil, and it was dumb {2974}. And it came to pass, when the devil {1140} was gone out {1831}, the dumb {2974} spake; and the people wondered.

Luke 11:15-20

Luke 11:15-20 But some of them said, He casteth out devils through Beelzebub the chief of the devils. 16 And others, tempting [him], sought of him a sign from heaven. 17 But he, knowing their thoughts, said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and a house [divided] against a house falleth. 18 If Satan also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? because you say that I cast out {1544} devils {1140} through Beelzebub. 19 And if I by Beelzebub cast out {1544} devils {1140}, by whom do your sons cast [them] out {1544}? therefore shall they be your judges. 20 But if I with the finger of God cast out {1544} devils {1140}, no doubt the kingdom of God is come upon you.

Luke 11:24-26

Luke 11:24-26 When the unclean spirit {169/4151} is gone out of {1831} a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he said, I will return unto my house whence I came out {1831}. 25 And when he cometh, he findeth [it] swept and garnished. 26 Then goeth he, and taketh [to him] seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last [state] of that man is worse than the first.

Luke 13:10-14

Luke 13:10-14 And he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath. 11 And, behold, there was a woman which had {2192} a spirit {4151} of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up [herself]. 12 And when Jesus saw her, he called [her to him], and said unto her, Woman, you art loosed from your infirmity. 13 And he laid [his] hands on {2007/5495} her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. 14 And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed {2323} on the sabbath day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed {2323}, and not on the sabbath day.

Luke 13:31-33

Luke 13:31-33 The same day there came certain of the Pharisees, saying unto him, Get you out, and depart hence: for Herod will kill you. 32 And he said unto them, Go you, and tell that fox, Behold, I cast out {1544} devils {1140}, and I do cures {2392} to day and to morrow, and the third [day] I shall be perfected. 33 Nevertheless I must walk to day, and to morrow, and the [day] following: for it cannot be that a prophet perish out of Jerusalem.

Luke 14:1-6

Luke 14:1-6 And it came to pass, as he went into the house of one of the chief Pharisees to eat bread on the sabbath day, that they watched him. 2 And, behold, there was a certain man before him which had the dropsy. 3 And Jesus answering spake unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, Is it lawful to heal {2323} on the sabbath day? 4 And they held their peace. And he took [him], and healed {2323} him, and let him go; 5 And answered them, saying, Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fallen into a pit, and will not straightway pull him out on the sabbath day? 6 And they could not answer him again to these things.

Luke 17:11-19

Luke 17:11-19 And it came to pass, as he went to Jerusalem, that he passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. 12 And as he entered into a certain village, there met him ten men that were lepers {3015}, which stood afar off: 13 And they lifted up [their] voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us. 14 And when he saw [them], he said unto them, Go show yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed {2511}. 15 And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God, 16 And fell down on [his] face at his feet, giving him thanks: and he was a Samaritan. 17 And Jesus answering said, Were there not ten cleansed {2511}? but where [are] the nine? 18 There are not found that returned to give glory to God, save this stranger. 19 And he said unto him, Arise, go your way: your faith has made you whole {4982}.

Luke 18:35-43

Luke 18:35-43 And it came to pass, that as he was come nigh unto Jericho, a certain blind {5185} man sat by the way side begging: 36 And hearing the multitude pass by, he asked what it meant. 37 And they told him, that Jesus of Nazareth passeth by. 38 And he cried, saying, Jesus, [you] Son of David, have mercy on me. 39 And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, [Thou] Son of David, have mercy on me. 40 And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto him: and when he was come near, he asked him, 41 Saying, What wilt you that I shall do unto you? And he said, Lord, that I may receive my sight. 42 And Jesus said unto him, Receive your sight: your faith has saved you. 43 And immediately he received his sight, and followed him, glorifying God: and all the people, when they saw [it], gave praise unto God.

Luke 19:37-38

Luke 19:37-38 And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works {1411} that they had seen; 38 Saying, Blessed [be] the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest.

Luke 22:3

Luke 22:3 Then entered Satan into {1525/1519} Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.

Luke 23:8

Luke 23:8 And when Herod saw Jesus, he was exceeding glad: for he was desirous to see him of a long [season], because he had heard many things of him; and he hoped to have seen some miracle {4592} done by him.

Luke 24:49

Luke 24:49 And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry you in the city of Jerusalem, until you be endued with power {1411} from on high.

4. POWER ENCOUNTERS IN JOHN

John 1:12

John 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power {1849} to become the sons of God, [even] to them that believe on his name:

John 2:11

John 2:11 This beginning of miracles {4592} did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

John 2:18

John 2:18 Then answered the Jews and said unto him, What sign {4592} shewest you unto us, seeing that you doest these things?

John 2:23-25

John 2:23-25 Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast [day], many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles {4592} which he did. 24 But Jesus did not commit himself unto them, because he knew all [men], 25 And needed not that any should testify of man: for he knew what was in man.

John 3:2

John 3:2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that you art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles {4592} that you doest, except God be with him.

John 4:46-54

John 4:46-54 So Jesus came again into Cana of Galilee, where he made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick {0770} at Capernaum. 47 When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal {2390} his son: for he was at the point of death. 48 Then said Jesus unto him, Except you see signs {4592} and wonders {5059}, you will not believe. 49 The nobleman said unto him, Sir, come down ere my child die. 50 Jesus said unto him, Go your way; your son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way. 51 And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told [him], saying, Your son liveth. 52 Then enquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever {4446} left him. 53 So the father knew that [it was] at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Your son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house. 54 This [is] again the second miracle {4592} [that] Jesus did, when he was come out of Judaea into Galilee.

John 5:1-16

John 5:1-16 After this there was a feast of the Jews; and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. 2 Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep [market] a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches. 3 In these lay a great multitude of impotent {0770} folk, of blind {5185}, halt {5560}, withered {3584}, waiting for the moving of the water. 4 For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole {5199} of whatsoever disease he had. 5 And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years. 6 When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time [in that case], he said unto him, Wilt you be made whole {5199}? 7 The impotent {0770} man answered him, Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me. 8 Jesus said unto him, Rise, take up your bed, and walk. 9 And immediately the man was made whole {5199}, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath. 10 The Jews therefore said unto him that was cured {2323}, It is the sabbath day: it is not lawful for you to carry [your] bed. 11 He answered them, He that made me whole {5199}, the same said unto me, Take up your bed, and walk. 12 Then asked they him, What man is that which said unto you, Take up your bed, and walk? 13 And he that was healed {2390} wist not who it was: for Jesus had conveyed himself away, a multitude being in [that] place. 14 Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, you art made whole {5199}: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto you. 15 The man departed, and told the Jews that it was Jesus, which had made him whole. 16 And therefore did the Jews persecute Jesus, and sought to slay him, because he had done these things on the sabbath day.

John 5:27

John 5:27 And has given him authority {1849} to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.

John 6:1-2

John 6:1-2 After these things Jesus went over the sea of Galilee, which is [the sea] of Tiberias. 2 And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles {4592} which he did on them that were diseased {0770}.

John 6:11-15

John 6:11-15 And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would. 12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost. 13 Therefore they gathered [them] together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten. 14 Then those men, when they had seen the miracle {4592} that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world. 15 When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

John 6:26-30

John 6:26-30 Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, You seek me, not because you saw the miracles {4592}, but because you did eat of the loaves, and were filled. 27 Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him has God the Father sealed. 28 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? 29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that you believe on him whom he has sent. 30 They said therefore unto him, What sign {4592} shewest you then, that we may see, and believe you? what dost you work?

John 6:70

John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil {1228}?

John 7:23 0.0.1.

John 7:23 If a man on the sabbath day receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are you angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole {5199} on the sabbath day?

John 7:31

John 7:31 And many of the people believed on him, and said, When Christ cometh, will he do more miracles {4592} than these which this [man] has done?

John 8:44-52

John 8:44-52 You are of [your] father the devil {1228}, and the lusts of your father you will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. 45 And because I tell [you] the truth, you believe me not. 46 Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do you not believe me? 47 He that is of God heareth God's words: you therefore hear [them] not, because you are not of God. 48 Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that you art a Samaritan, and hast a devil {1140}? 49 Jesus answered, I have {2192} not a devil {1140}; but I honour my Father, and you do dishonour me. 50 And I seek not mine own glory: there is one that seeketh and judgeth. 51 Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death. 52 Then said the Jews unto him, Now we know that you hast a devil {1140}. Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and you sayest, If a man keep my saying, he shall never taste of death.

John 9:1-7

John 9:1-7 And as [Jesus] passed by, he saw a man which was blind {5185} from [his] birth. 2 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was

born blind {5185}? 3 Jesus answered, Neither has this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him. 4 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work. 5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world. 6 When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind {5185} man with the clay, 7 And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

John 9:16

John 9:16 Therefore said some of the Pharisees, This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day. Others said, How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles {4592}? And there was a division among them.

John 10:18-21

John 10:18-21 No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power {1849} to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father. 19 There was a division therefore again among the Jews for these sayings. 20 And many of them said, He has a devil {1140}, and is mad; why hear you him? 21 Others said, These are not the words of him that has a devil {1139}. Can a devil {1140} open the eyes of the blind {5185}?

John 10:39-42

John 10:39-42 Therefore they sought again to take him: but he escaped out of their hand, 40 And went away again beyond Jordan into the place where John at first baptized; and there he abode. 41 And many resorted unto him, and said, John did no miracle {4592}; but all things that John spake of this man were true. 42 And many believed on him there.

John 11:1-6; 11-15; 23-27; 40-45

Now a certain [man] was sick {0770}, [named] Lazarus, of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha. 2 (It was [that] Mary which anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped his feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick {0770}.) 3 Therefore his sisters sent unto him, saying, Lord, behold, he whom you lovest is sick {0770}. 4 When Jesus heard [that], he said, This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby. 5 Now Jesus loved Martha, and her sister, and Lazarus. 6 When he had heard therefore that he was sick {0770}, he abode two days still in the same place where he was.

These things said he: and after that he said unto them, Our friend Lazarus sleepeth; but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep. 12 Then said his disciples, Lord, if he sleep, he shall do well. 13 Howbeit Jesus spake of his death: but they thought that he had spoken of taking of rest in sleep. 14 Then said Jesus unto them plainly, Lazarus is dead. 15 And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent you may believe; nevertheless let us go unto him.

Jesus said unto her, Your brother shall rise again. 24 Martha said unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day. 25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: 26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this? 27 She said unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that you art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.

Jesus said unto her, Said I not unto you, that, if you wouldest believe, you shouldest see the glory of God? 41 Then they took away the stone [from the place] where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up [his] eyes, and said, Father, I thank you that you hast heard me. 42 And I knew that you hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said [it], that they may believe that you hast sent me. 43 And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. 44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus said unto them, Loose him, and let him go. 45 Then many of the Jews which came to Mary, and had seen the things which Jesus did, believed on him.

John 11:37

John 11:37 And some of them said, Could not this man, which opened the eyes of the blind {5185}, have caused that even this man should not have died?

John 11:47-48

John 11:47-48 Then gathered the chief priests and the Pharisees a council, and said, What do we? for this man doeth many miracles {4592}. 48 If we let him thus alone, all [men] will believe on him: and the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation.

John 12:17-19

John 12:17-19 17 The people therefore that was with him when he called Lazarus out of his grave, and raised him from the dead, bare record. 18 For this cause the people also met him, for that they heard that he had done this miracle {4592}. 19 The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive you how you prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him.

John 12:31-33

John 12:31-33 Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out {1544}. 32 And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all [men] unto me. 33 This he said, signifying what death he should die.

John 12:37-41

John 12:37-41 But though he had done so many miracles {4592} before them, yet they believed not on him: 38 That the saying of Esaias the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spake, Lord, who has believed our report? and to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? 39 Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again, 40 He has blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with [their] eyes, nor understand with [their]

heart, and be converted, and I should heal {2390} them. 41 These things said Esaias, when he saw his glory, and spake of him.

John 13:2

John 13:27 And after the sop Satan entered into {1525/1519} him. Then said Jesus unto him, That you doest, do quickly.

John 17:1-2

John 17:1-2 These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify your Son, that your Son also may glorify you: 2 As you hast given him power {1849} over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as you hast given him.

John 20:30

John 20:30 And many other signs {4592} truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book:

5. POWER ENCOUNTERS IN ACTS

Acts 1:8

Acts 1:8 But you shall receive power {1411}, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and you shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Acts 2:17-21

Acts 2:17-21 And it shall come to pass in the last days, said God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: 18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: 19 And I will show wonders {4592} in heaven above, and signs {4592} in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: 20 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come: 21 And it shall come to pass, [that] whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Acts 2:22

Acts 2:22 You men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles {1411} and wonders {4592} and signs {4592}, which God did by him in the midst of you, as you yourselves also know:

Acts 2:43

Acts 2:43 And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders {4592} and signs {4592} were done by the apostles.

Acts 3:2

Acts 3:2 And a certain man lame {5560} from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;

Acts 3:11-12

Acts 3:11-12 And as the lame {5560} man which was healed {2390} held Peter and John, all the people ran together unto them in the porch that is called Solomon's, greatly wondering. 12 And when Peter saw [it], he answered unto the people, You men of Israel, why marvel you at this? or why look you so earnestly on us, as though by our own power {1411} or holiness we had made this man to walk?

Acts 4:7-14

Acts 4:7-14 And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power {1411}, or by what name, have you done this? 8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Ghost, said unto them, You rulers of the people, and elders of Israel, 9 If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent {772} man, by what means he is made whole {4982}; 10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, [even] by him doth this man stand here before you whole {5199}. 11 This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. 12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. 13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus. 14 And beholding the man which was healed {2323} standing with them, they could say nothing against it.

Acts 4:16

Acts 4:16 Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle {4592} has been done by them [is] manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny [it].

Acts 4:22

Acts 4:22 For the man was above forty years old, on whom this miracle {4592} of healing {2392} was shewed.

Acts 4:29-33

Acts 4:29-33 And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto your servants, that with all boldness they may speak your word, 30 By stretching forth your hand to heal {2392}; and that signs {4592} and wonders {4592} may be done by the name of your holy child Jesus. 31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness. 32 And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any [of them] that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common. 33 And with great power {1411} gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.

Acts 5:12-16

Acts 5:12-16 And by the hands of the apostles were many signs {4592} and wonders {4592} wrought among the people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch. 13 And of the rest durst no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them. 14 And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.) 15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick {772} into the streets, and laid [them] on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them. 16 There came also a multitude [out] of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick {772} folks, and them

which were vexed {3791} with unclean spirits {169/4151}: and they were healed {2323} every one.

Acts 6:8

Acts 6:8 And Stephen, full of faith and power {1411}, did great wonders {4592} and miracles {4592} among the people.

Acts 7:36

Acts 7:36 He brought them out, after that he had shewed wonders {4592} and signs {4592} in the land of Egypt, and in the Red sea, and in the wilderness forty years.

Acts 8:4-8

preaching the word. 5 Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them. 6 And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles {4592} which he did. 7 For unclean spirits {169/4151}, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed {2192} [with them]: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame {5560}, were healed {2323}. 8 And there was great joy in that city.

Acts 8:9-13

Acts 8:9-13 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: 10 To whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, This man is the great power {1411} of God. 11 And to him they had regard, because that of long time he had bewitched them with sorceries. 12 But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women. 13 Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles {1411} and signs {4592} which were done.

Acts 8:14-19

Acts 8:14-19 Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John: 15 Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost: 16 (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.) 17 Then laid {2007} they [their] hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost. 18 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, 19 Saying, Give me also this power {1849}, that on whomsoever I lay {2007} hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.

Acts 9:12-18

Acts 9:12-18 And has seen in a vision a man named Ananias coming in, and putting {2007} [his] hand on him, that he might receive his sight. 13 Then Ananias answered, Lord, I have heard by many of this man, how much evil he has done to your saints at Jerusalem: 14 And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on your name. 15 But the Lord said unto him, Go your way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel: 16 For I will show him how great things he must suffer for my name's sake. 17 And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting {2007} his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, [even] Jesus, that appeared unto you in the way as you camest, has sent me, that you mightest receive your sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost. 18 And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized.

Acts 9:32-35

Acts 9:32-35 And it came to pass, as Peter passed throughout all [quarters], he came down also to the saints which dwelt at Lydda. 33 And there he found a certain man named Aeneas, which had kept his bed eight years, and was sick of the palsy. 34 And Peter said unto him, Aeneas, Jesus Christ maketh you whole {2390}: arise, and make your bed. And he arose immediately. 35 And all that dwelt at Lydda and Saron saw him, and turned to the Lord.

Acts 9:36-43

Acts 9:36-43 Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this woman was full of good works and almsdeeds which she did. 37 And it came to pass in those days, that she was sick {770}, and died: whom when they had washed, they laid [her] in an upper chamber. 38 And forasmuch as Lydda was nigh to Joppa, and the disciples had heard that Peter was there, they sent unto him two men, desiring [him] that he would not delay to come to them. 39 Then Peter arose and went with them. When he was come, they brought him into the upper chamber: and all the widows stood by him weeping, and shewing the coats and garments which Dorcas made, while she was with them. 40 But Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning [him] to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up. 41 And he gave her [his] hand, and lifted her up, and when he had called the saints and widows, presented her alive. 42 And it was known throughout all Joppa; and many believed in the Lord. 43 And it came to pass, that he tarried many days in Joppa with one Simon a tanner.

Acts 10:36-38

Acts 10:36-38 The word which [God] sent unto the children of Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ: (he is Lord of all:) 37 That word, [I say], you know, which was published throughout all Judaea, and began from Galilee, after the baptism which John preached; 38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power {1411}: who went about doing good, and healing {2390} all that were oppressed of the devil {1228}; for God was with him.

Acts 13:10

Acts 13:10 And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, [you] child of the devil {1228}, [you] enemy of all righteousness, wilt you not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?

Acts 14:3

Acts 14:3 Long time therefore abode they speaking boldly in the Lord, which gave testimony unto the word of his grace, and granted signs {4592} and wonders {4592} to be done by their hands.

Acts 14:8-10

Acts 14:8-10 And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple {5560} from his mother's womb, who never had walked: 9 The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed {4982}, 10 Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on your feet. And he leaped and walked.

Acts 15:12

Acts 15:12 Then all the multitude kept silence, and gave audience to Barnabas and Paul, declaring what miracles {4592} and wonders {4592} God had wrought among the Gentiles by them.

Acts 16:16-19

Acts 16:16-19 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed {2192} with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: 17 The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which show unto us the way of salvation. 18 And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command you in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour. 19 And when her masters saw that the hope of their gains was gone, they caught Paul and Silas, and drew [them] into the marketplace unto the rulers,

Acts 19:3-6

Acts 19:3-6 And he said unto them, Unto what then were you baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. 4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. 5 When they heard [this], they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. 6 And when Paul had laid {2007} [his] hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

Acts 19:11-20

Acts 19:11-20 And God wrought special miracles {1411} by the hands of Paul: 12 So that from his body were brought unto the sick {770} handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases {3554} departed from them, and the evil spirits {4190/4151} went out of them. 13 Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had {2192} evil spirits {4190/4151} the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth. 14 And there were seven sons of [one] Sceva, a Jew, [and] chief of the priests, which did so. 15 And the evil spirit {4190/4151} answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are you? 16 And the man in whom the evil spirit {4190/4151} was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded. 17 And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified. 18 And many that believed came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds. 19 Many of them also which used curious arts brought their books together, and burned them before all [men]: and they counted the price of them, and found [it] fifty thousand [pieces] of silver. 20 So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed.

Acts 26:18

Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, [and] to turn [them] from darkness to light, and [from] the power {1849} of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.0

Acts 28:7-9

Acts 28:7-9 In the same quarters were possessions of the chief man of the island, whose name was Publius; who received us, and lodged us three days courteously. 8 And it came to pass, that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever {4446} and of a bloody flux: to whom Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid {2007} his hands on him, and healed {2390} him. 9 So when this was done, others also, which had diseases in the island, came, and were healed{2323}:

Acts 28:25-27

Acts 28:25-27 And when they agreed not among themselves, they departed, after that Paul had spoken one word, Well spake the Holy Ghost by Esaias the prophet unto our fathers, 26 Saying, Go unto this people, and say, Hearing you shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing you shall see, and not perceive: 27 For the heart of this people is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes have they closed; lest they should see with [their] eyes, and hear with [their] ears, and understand with [their] heart, and should be converted, and I should heal {2390} them.
